

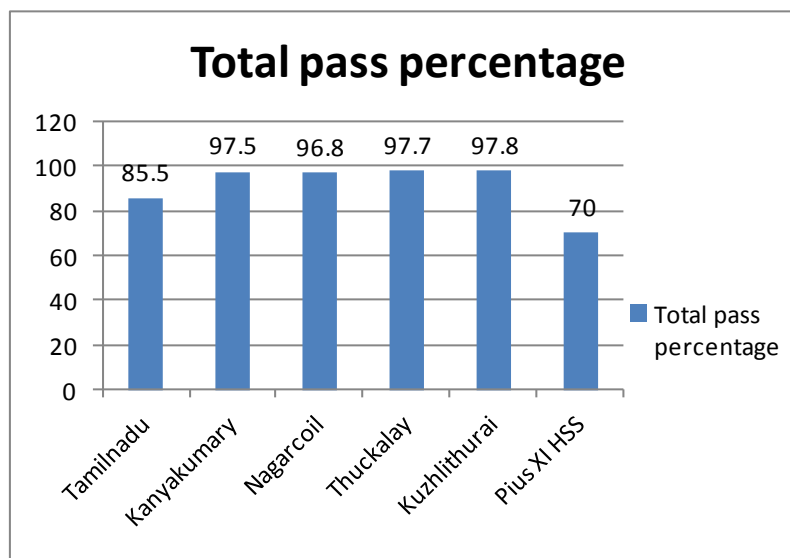
A Brief Analysis on +2 2011 Result in Pius XI HSS



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The Tamilnadu state HSC results for the year 2011 are announced recently. The table and graph below show the comparative HSC result in our Pius XI HSS and in other region.

The above +2 Exams results-2011 analysis shows that Pass percentage of Pius XI HSS has come down from the previous year and also it is being away from the pass percentage Tamil Nadu state in 15.50%, Kanyakumari district in 27.50%, Schools of

Nagercoil Division in 26.80%, Thuckalay Division in 27.70% and Kuzhlithurai Division in 27.80%. Even though Pius XI HSS is one of the oldest school in the state, its pass percentage is not the highest and 30% of students failed to be passed, at least, in the exam after spending seven long years at the same school. This is an eye opener and a serious matter of concern for us. What is the main reason for such a downward trend on the academic performance of the school?
